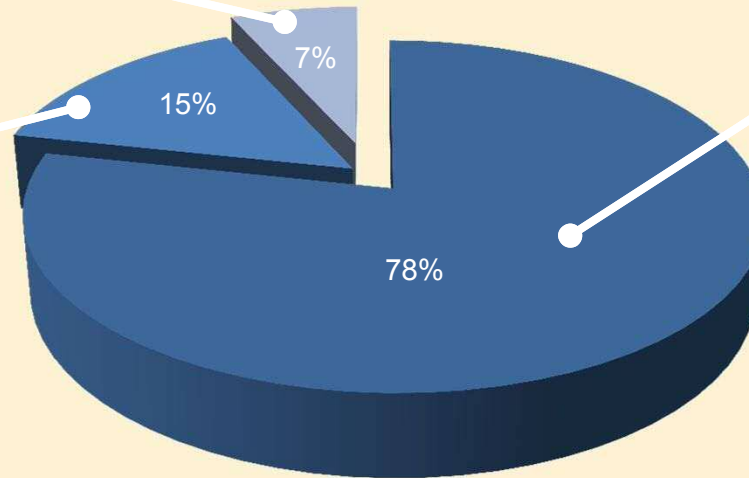

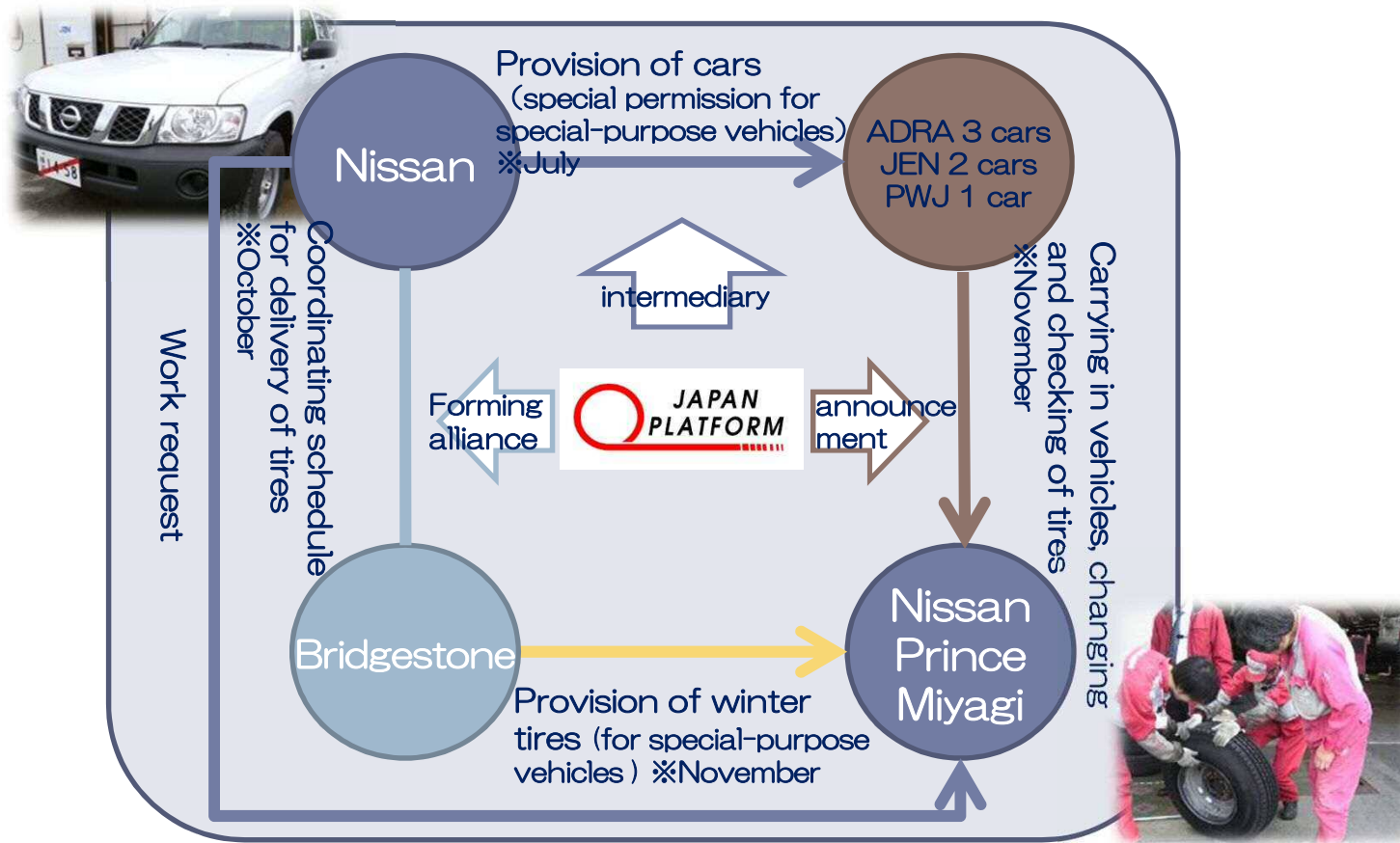

Alliance with companies: Support for NGO vehicles by Nissan and Bridgestone

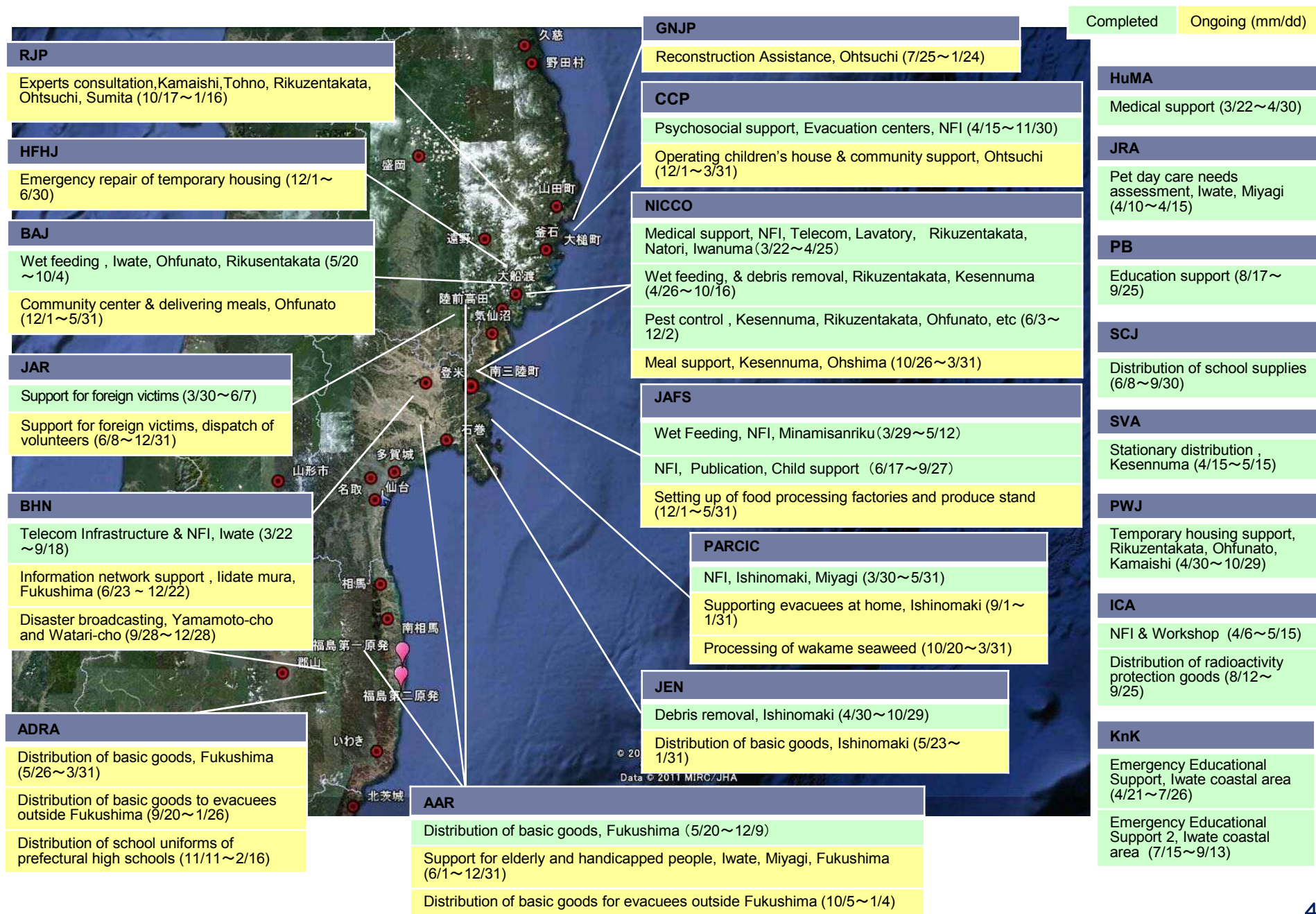
— JPF as a hub constructing a scheme 'Provision and maintenance of vehicles and winter tires' with the cooperation from industrial firms—

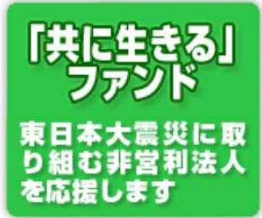
Vehicles by the courtesy of Nissan are playing important roles in support operations in the field. Winter tires were essential with snow starting to fall in the affected areas. However, it was difficult to obtain winter tires because the vehicles were special-purposed and generally not used in Japan. To this end, tires for special-purposed vehicles were kindly provided by Bridgestone and the service of changing and checking of tires by Nissan Prince Miyagi. Vehicles from Nissan are able to perform important tasks in affected area with the support from these companies.
