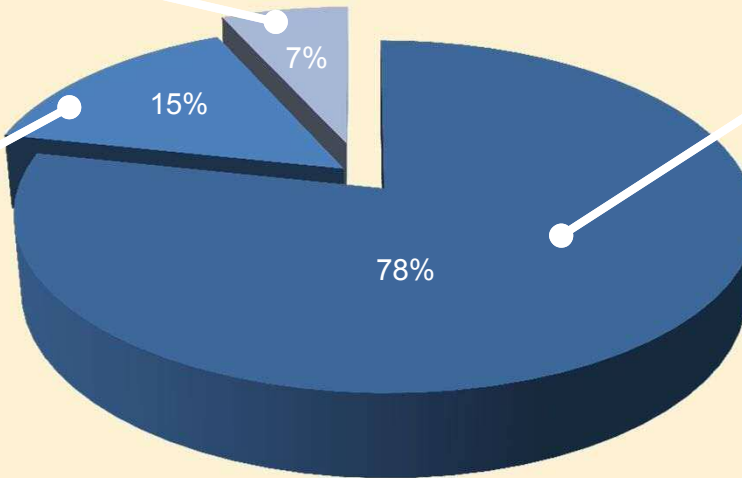

Japan Platform's Current Approach

Japan Platform's approach to North East Pacific Japan Earthquake and Tsunami is not confined to providing grants to NGOs. We evaluate activities which we have granted and coordinate the provision of heating appliances in collaboration with support organizations and local governments.

●Evaluation Mission

The primary aim of the evaluation mission is to draw lessons and proposals for future support activities and to share them with organizations and people involved. Four specialists and a member of JPF conduct this mission.

We are conducting field surveys from this month. Discussions with NGOs in March will be followed by the preparation of reports.

<Evaluating method>

- ① An evaluation by evaluation index (adequateness, appropriateness / connectedness, sustainability / efficiency / validity / coordination / impact)
- ② An evaluation by specialists

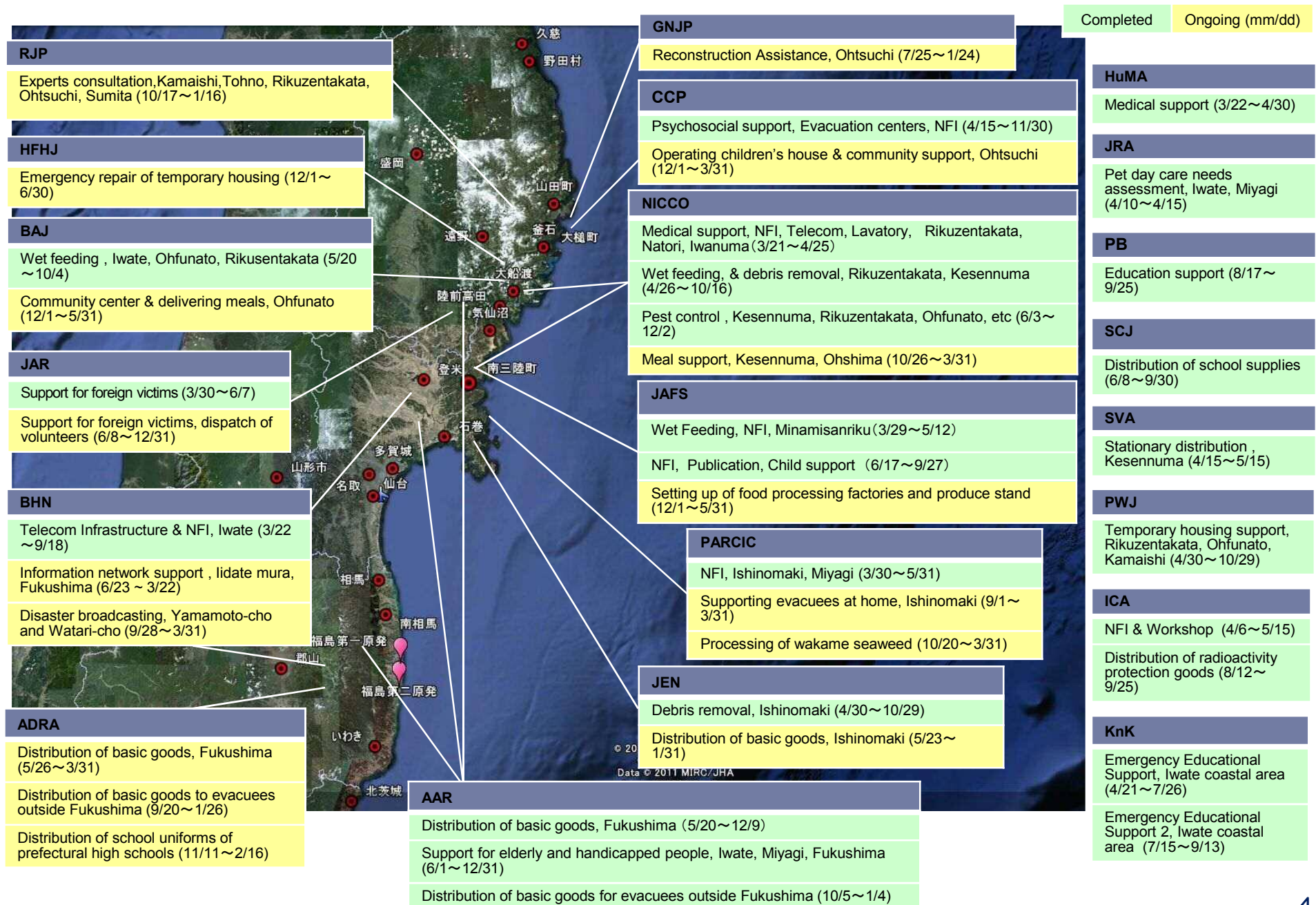
●Provision of heating appliances to general house regarded as temporary housing

We have made an adjustment to the countermeasure to the coldness in Iwate, Miyagi and Fukushima in collaboration with the NGO unit members, NGOs and NPOs campaigning in the affected areas, and local governments.

We agreed on the division of roles: Public administration will be supporting heating appliance provision in temporary housing, and the NGOs and NPOs will be assisting people living in general houses such as privately-rented housing regarded as temporary house. Therefore, minimum heating appliances have been secured for affected people in 3 disaster-struck prefectures. In addition, the cooperation from industrial firms which could provide appliances was essential. We will continue to support Tohoku by closely coordinating with companies, public administration, and supporting organization operating on-site.
